The results are in – and we are having an impact! Since receiving our 501(c)3 status in May, 2014, we have made amazing progress. Below are some of the highlights:



Althouse Arboretum

"Where Preservation and Education Intersect"

- Over 100 volunteers gave more than 500 volunteer hours to begin converting the property into a unique destination for environmental learning
- 2,200 feet of trails created for both passive recreation and active learning
- Empowered students, advisors and community members to develop a Master Plan to include handicap accessible gardens, a Children’s Forest, outdoor classrooms, and more
- Students Teaching Students programs initiated
- Awarded two grants to create Penn’s Woods Trail to showcase native PA ecosystems to visitors and to create a Model Right of Way to demonstrate how residents can coexist with utility lines by proper planting of native trees and shrubs
- Created “Friends of the Althouse Arboretum” with local students and community partners
- Hosted FREE public events including Night Hike, children’s events, and class visits



Green Allies Network

"Growing a Network of Empowered Students"

- Assisted local students in the creation of a new environmental service club.
- Have over 50 Advisors in 17 states that initiate and assist in student programs
- Hosted Earth Day event with more than 400 students attending and over 50 student leaders attending a leadership dinner
- Helping middle school students do their own “waste audit” of their school to propose ideas on how to reduce waste and recycle more. A manual will be produced and printed for other schools to follow.
- Creating a Scientific Advisory Board to provide professional assistance to student projects
- Helped a high school start a community garden project to grow food for a local food bank
- Helping campus organizations to host a college student sustainability conference.
- Helping students in several locations initiate school-wide composting and garden projects
