2024 Schedule: HALF DAY and FULL DAY

Week One: June 3 - 7 Nature and Wildlife Week HALF and FULL DAY

Wildlife is all around us at the Arboretum as long as we know where to look. Become a wilderness explorer and learn some of the tricks about being in nature. Learn about the cute and maybe not so cute creatures that live in the wild, and the habitats they occupy! We will go on scavenger hunts, catch insects, and explore the Arboretum's many habitats to find out what lives in our woods, ponds and fields. A great week of animal games, education about our environment, and fun.

Week Two: June 10 - 14 Music Week HALF and FULL DAY

This week is jam packed full with different opportunities to see how the world can be full of music. From learning how to make drums to trying to replicate bird calls, this week is bound to be a fun way to learn about the importance of our music in different cultures. This week also tests the kids' listening skills and allows them to experience more hands-on learning in nature during the summer months.

Week Three: June 17 – 21 Spy Week HALF and FULL DAY

This week the campers are asked to become detectives and try to use the clues to solve the mysteries of the Althouse Arboretum Island. Kids will be able to learn and advance their spy skills by identifying fingerprints, solving crime scenes, and playing outdoor games that require problem solving skills. We love testing their mental and physical abilities on our famous obstacle course. Mysteries involved allow kids to play a real life version of the game "Clue" with crimes like the "Pool-Noodle Thief". Loads of fun and creativity will be found during this week!

Week Four: June 24 - 28 Magic Forest Week HALF and FULL DAY

We will transform the Arboretum into a magical forest where all kinds of fun things will happen. With a Harry Potter inspiration, campers will learn how to do magic tricks; play unusual games; solve mysteries and puzzles; and learn how to create some great (and useful) potions. We will also learn about the magical creatures that are in our fantasy stories and from our very own woods. We will also look at the mythology that influences the magic of the world around us and learn tales of famous heroes like Hercules.

Week Five: July 8 - 12 Time Traveling Week HALF and FULL DAY

This week we will be examining different places in time as time travelers to learn about our past to help us succeed in the future. Come and explore as we travel into the past to see our roots, and uncover what could happen as we travel to the future. We will explore all types of historical events that have occurred like the dinosaur stages, different time eras, natural disasters, along with discovering future possibilities. Lots of imagination and creativity was involved during this week with the best version of history class!

Week Six: July 15 – 19 Water Week

Be ready to get wet as we dive into water week! This year we will focus our camp on the amazing oceans and the life that lives under the sea. On top of our fun water games, we will explore sea shells, learn how sharks can find their way in the water, and even find out about some of the most amazing underwater creatures on the planet. Don't forget your bathing suit because we will be getting wet with water games and water activities.
